■ FCL-MEDICAL CRD

End of June, EASA has published the CRD on the medical part after months of negotiation with several stakeholders (large influence of the AME lobby!). When studying the final outcome, it seems that the relaxations for the recreational aviation as for seen in the Basis Regulation, is changed in such away that they become hardly to implement.

Our TO Licensing, Meike Müller, received reactions from several members and from the board and posted last week our response towards EASA. (Comments are attached for your information).

■ FCL-LICENSING "Opinion"

Last Friday "Opinion 04/2010" was published by EASA. This the final proposal by EASA for approval by the EU-Commission. After adopting a new regulation with 'Implementing Rules" for licensing will be published. The EU-Licensing system will start on 08-04-2012 as decided in the BR but we might expect a transfer period up to 3 years for gliding licences.
